One: The image of God is seen clearly through the lens of diversity, equity, and inclusion, the living dance of the Holy Trinity.

All: All are created in the image of God, diverse, equitable, and inclusive.

One: The Holy Trinity is diverse. The Creator is not the Savior. The Savior is not the Creator. The Creator is not the Gift. The Gift is not the Creator nor the Savior and neither the Creator nor the Savior is the Gift.

All: In our diversity, we reflect the image of God.

One: The Holy Trinity is equitable. The Creator is not of greater importance than the Savior. The Savior is not more important than the Creator. The Gift is not of greater importance than the Creator nor Savior and neither is more important than the Gift.

All: In our equity, we reflect the image of God.

One: The Holy Trinity is inclusive. The Creator does not stand alone but depends upon the presence of the Savior and the Gift. The Savior does not stand alone but depends upon the presence of the Creator and the Gift. The Gift does not stand alone but depends upon the presence of the Creator and the Savior.

All: In our inclusion, we reflect the image of God.

One: All are invited to join this holy embrace, to reflect fully the image of God. All are invited to join their diversity with the Holy. All are invited to share with Them to join in Their equity. All are invited to be, to embrace with Them, totally included; to become one as they are one.

All: All are created to reflect the image of God by embracing diversity, equity, and inclusiveness.
